RP	Shoulder in right
PL	Half circle 10 m
L – between R&M	Half pass to the right
RMCH	Collected trot
HXF	Extended trot
F	Collected trot
A	Halt. Rein back 3-5 steps and proceed in collected walk
KLB	Collected walk.
BIH	Extended walk.
HC	Collected walk.
C	Proceed in collected canter right lead
PV	Half circle right 20m diameter in collected canter, give and retake reins for few strides
VE	Collected canter
EIM	Change rein
Crossing centre line	Flying change of leg
MCH	Collected canter
HV	Extended canter
VKAF	Collected canter
FLE	Change rein
Crossing centre line	Flying change of leg
SR	Half circle right 20m diameter in medium canter
R	Collected canter
Between P&F	Collected trot
A	Turn down centre line
X	Halt – Immobility - Salute

1. Trot Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity, impulsion, swinging back, ground cover, ability to collect		
2. Walk Rhythm, relaxation, activity, ground cover		
3. Canter Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity, natural balance, impulsion, ground cover, uphill tendency		
4. Submission Suppleness, contact, straightness, obedience		
5. General Impression As a potential young dressage horse, standard of training (on the basis of the "scale of training" according to age, transitions within paces
